The Rates and Charges document has been updated for 2021 for the increase in T-hangar rates. This increase is based on the plan approved by the Board in 2017 when the new T-hangars were built and is incorporated into the lease agreements.

The proposed 2021 O&M and Capital Improvement budgets were provided to the Board at the October 13, 2020, regular Board meeting. A budget consultation meeting was held with the airlines on October 14th. The only change to the revised budget is the addition of a CIP project which will install pathways and sensors on a portion of Runway 05. The total cost of this project is \$98,680 and it will be funded by the Authority. There were no other changes to the proposed 2021 budget based on Board or airline feedback.
